

Atal Amrit Abhiyan Society, Assam

Atal Amrit Abhiyan Society, Assam is responsible for implementation of Atal Amrit Abhiyan and Ayushman Bharat-Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana Schemes in the State of Assam.

1) Atal Amrit Abhiyan Scheme:

Under Atal Amrit Abhiyan Scheme, cashless treatment upto Rs.2.0 lakhs to the BPL and APL (Annual family income below Rs.5.0 lakhs) individuals is provided for treatment of Cancer, Cardiovascular diseases, Kidney diseases, Neo Natal diseases, Neurological conditions, Burns, ICU treatment, Trauma, Critical Care Paediatrics, Paediatric Surgery, Japanese Encephalitis & Acute Encephalitis Syndrome and Supplementary packages in the empanelled hospitals both within and outside the State.

TA/DA of Rs. 300/- per day for a maximum of 10 days within Assam and Rs.1000/- per day for a maximum of 10 days outside Assam is given to the beneficiaries. Air Fare for a maximum of Rs.30,000/- per year is given to the beneficiaries for treatment outside the State is given. Rs. 12.48 lakhs have been paid for air tickets to the beneficiaries for treatment outside the State.

20% incentive from the hospital claims amount is paid to the treating staff of the Government hospitals. Rs.25.89 lakhs has been paid as incentive to the medical staff from the hospital claims amount in case of Government hospitals. Enrolment kiosks are available in all Districts.

78 hospitals have been empanelled under the Scheme out of which 55 hospitals are within the State and 23 hospitals are outside the State. Till date 1,62,50,053 beneficiaries have been enrolled under Atal Amrit Abhiyan Scheme and 2,58,107 beneficiaries have availed free cashless treatment. 3169 beneficiaries from Assam have availed cashless treatment outside the State under the Scheme.

Rs.347.77 crores have been paid as hospital claims till date.

Arogya Mitras are deployed in the empaneled hospitals to hand hold and guide the beneficiaries. Steps are taken for self-enrolment through an online portal under the Scheme where eligible beneficiaries can enroll themselves without visiting any kiosk.

2) Ayushman Bharat-Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana Scheme:

Ayushman Bharat-Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana, aims to provide cashless treatment upto Rs.5.0 lakhs to already identified 27 lakhs families in the State of Assam as per Socio Economic Caste Census 2011. This family floater scheme covers 1578 procedures under 25 specialties.2,22,215 beneficiaries have availed cashless treatment under the Scheme.

335 hospitals have been empanelled under the Scheme.Rs.198.55 crores have been paid as hospital claims till date. TA/DA of Rs.2.31 crores have been paid to the PMJAY beneficiaries from the State fund.Rs.4.43 crores has been paid as incentive to the medical staff from the hospital claims amount in case of Government hospitals.

Pradhan Mantri Arogya Mitras deployed in the empaneled Government hospitals to hand hold and guide the beneficiaries. Steps are taken to launch "Apke Dwar Ayushman" where Aadhar based PMJAY cards will be issued to the identified beneficiaries at near to home locations.
